Raj Dhir has been the Executive Director and Chief Legal Counsel at the Ontario Human Rights Commission (OHRC) for the last four years. He was previously a Portfolio Director with the Ministry of the Attorney General Civil Law Division, where he spent over a decade in a variety of management roles including as Legal Director at the former Ministry of Indigenous Relations and Reconciliation and as Deputy Legal Director in roles at the Crown Law Office Civil and the Constitutional Law Branches within the Ministry of the Attorney General, and in the Ministry of Labour (Litigation and Solicitor Practices).

Raj also spent over 11 years as counsel at the OHRC, where he litigated and advised on a variety of human rights matters and appeared before administrative tribunals and at all levels of court, including the Supreme Court of Canada.
